	<b>Comprehension Questions</b>
8s	Where/ when is this clip set? Who might live here? Why is the flower unusual?
16s	What type of character is Olaf? Why is he so amazed by the flower and why do you think he says 'hello' to it?
22s	Why is the moose excited to see the carrot? How and why does the music change? What do you think will happen next?
30s	Why does Olaf laugh? Do you think he might regret this? Have you ever laughed at someone and regretted it later? How did it make you feel?
50s	Why are the characters struggling to get the carrot? Do they want it for different reasons?
1m 10s	How and why does the music change? How do Olaf's emotions change at this point? What do you think the moose might do?
1m 22s	Thinking about what has happened so far, why are the moose's actions surprising? What Christian values is he showing by the way he behaves? What does this tell us about his character? How do you think this made Olaf feel?
End of film	If you could choose, what title would you give this clip? Why have you chosen this?
<b>THINKING!</b> 	How do you think both characters felt at the end of this clip? What do you think the message of the clip could be? What is the film encouraging viewers to do/ think about?
