
What is the Phonics Screening Check?

- It is the only statutory test undertaken by children in Year 1
- It takes place in the summer term (usually June)
- Children read 40 words
 - \circ Real words
 - Alien words
- Pass mark is unknown until after the test has been administered
- You will receive a 'Yes' or 'No' to tell you if your child has passed the test
- There is another opportunity in Year 2 to retake the test

How can I help my child at home?

- Read with your child at home at least 3 times a week.
- When reading encourage your child to use their phonics to read unfamiliar words.
- Encourage sounding and saying the whole word.
